

COVID-19 UPDATE

At Chabad of Plano, we take the responsibility of creating as safe and sanitary environment as is possible for those who choose to participate in the activities happening here.

We are so pleased to be able to share with you that thanks to a generous member, we have been able to purchase a \$3,000 Professional Cordless Electrostatic Backpack Sprayer to sanitize the building daily. This sprayer can be used on the chairs, tables, bima, door handles, faucets, handrails, toys etc.. This is the kind of machine used to sanitize airplanes, hospitals, schools and for commercial office settings.

We have installed eight hand sanitizing dispensers all over the building for easy access. Masks are available upon entry for anyone who does not come with their own. Every person who enters the building must wear a mask. The Shul has been reconfigured to allow for social distancing during services.
